2011 will mark the celebration of 100 Women in Hedge Funds' 10th anniversary. When our Founders, along with exactly 100 women, first met in December 2001, no one could have imagined the size and scope that the organization would take over the next ten years. None of this would have been possible without the efforts and support of our members, volunteers, Angels, Board, host firms, Leadership Council Donors, service providers, and the list goes on...

Today we have more than 10,000 members in 14 locations on 3 continents. Our members represent over 2,800 hedge funds, 1,000 Fund of Funds and 500 institutional buyers. Additionally, our members represent the various roles within financial organizations and we are proud to say that our membership includes over 1,600 portfolio managers and research analysts, as well as over 1,000 senior executives including CEOs, Presidents, COOs and CCOs. Ten years after our founding, we still strive to meet our core mission:
