Founded in 1977, Solidarité Femmes is a Swiss charity, which offers social and psychological support, shelter and mentoring to women and children affected by domestic violence. Recognised and supported by the State of Geneva, it counts many renowned public and private institutions among its supporters, including Cargill International, Migros Genève, Lions Club Genève, Omega, Loterie Romande. Although immediate assistance is offered to the mother and children, its programmes focus on the family unit and the importance of the role of the father.

Solidarité Femmes has developed many advanced programmes which promote a healthy mother-child relationship, individual and family progression. Its services are offered by handful of highly trained professionals both in centres in Geneva and via a nationwide helpline.

Funds raised by 100 Women in Hedge Funds will go towards a project being led by Solidarité Femmes which will extend its knowledge of family problems arising from domestic violence into community services within Geneva. The objective of the training is to sensitise community, social and health workers to issues of isolation, post-traumatic stress disorder and breakdown of normal family relationships that are common in such situations and so to facilitate early detection of domestic instability and ensure that victims are properly and promptly assisted.

100 women in hedge funds A Gala Cocktail Dînatoire in Geneva was held by 100 Women in Hedge Funds on **29 September 2009** in support of Association Païdos, a Swiss charity dedicated to educational programmes for disadvantaged children. Thanks to the support and generosity of sponsors, donors and ticket buyers the total amount raised was **CHF 135,000**, enabling Paidos to dramatically expand its "Getting Back into Learning" project and bring hope into the lives of more troubled teens.

The event took place at the two-Michelin-starred **Restaurant Hôtel du Parc des Eaux-Vives**, an 18th-century mansion situated in verdant parkland overlooking the lake of Geneva.

Following a welcome speech and presentation of the work of Association Païdos, frantic bidding ensued in a live auction conducted by the Managing Director of Sotheby's Geneva. Among the unique and exclusive celebrity items on offer was VIP seating at a dinner concert by Oscar-winning film director, writer and actor Woody Allen and his jazz band together with signed memorabilia, a signed photo and self-portrait by Phil Collins, an exclusive Vodafone McLaren Mercedes shirt signed by Lewis Hamilton, seats at the Closing Night premiere of the London Film Festival and dream vacations in the Dominican Republic, Lugano and Geneva, incorporating the use of a top of the range sports car, luxury label accessories and designer watches.



Among the fabulous tombola prizes on offer were a 5^{*} spa weekend away with an Aston Martin, short breaks to Istanbul and Marrakech, works of art, Chamonix lift passes, and dozens of travel, hotel and gift vouchers. The evening concluded with guests dancing to a smooth salsa band as the moonlight reflected on the lake below.





Association Païdos is a Swiss charity dedicated to developing and implementing educational programmes for disadvantaged children facing severe social problems and left with few prospects. It works with children that have dropped out of the system, assists them to regain confidence and rediscover self-worth, appreciate the benefit of learning and provides facilities to enable them to catch-up and pass entrance requirements before re-entering formal education or training.
