Effie (Anagnostopoulos) Datson, Head of FX and Global Macro Prime Brokerage, Deutsche Bank

Effie Datson is the head of FX and Global Macro Prime Brokerage for Deutsche Bank in Europe. She was previously the Business Development Manager at IKOS, a systematic, quantitative equity and global macro trading fund. Prior to this, Ms. Datson was a trader / researcher at R.G. Niederhoffer Capital Management, a systematic, short-term futures and currency trading fund based in New York. She gained broad exposure to the hedge fund industry and investment experience as a hedge fund analyst at Rutherford Asset Management, an investment company of the Lord Jacob Rothschild family office. Prior to this, Ms. Datson spent eight years at Goldman Sachs & Co., where she was a Vice President in the Foreign Exchange, responsible for covering central bank, hedge fund and corporate clients in North America, as well as developing the bank's FX eCommerce platform.
