She is assistant portfolio manager of the group's flagship products, and portfolio manager of the emerging hedge fund products. She also leads the global macro, commodity, and quantitative equity manager due diligence effort. In addition, Tanya has served as head of quantitative portfolio analysis, having developed optimization models for hedge fund strategies, and performance attribution models to evaluate profit contribution from asset allocation versus manager selection. She has written and co-authored several articles appearing in professional journals and educational publications, including: "The Case for Global Macro," *DB Absolute Return Strategies* (2004); "Do Hedge Funds Belong in Taxable Portfolios?" *Journal of Wealth Management* (2001); and "Private Equity as an Asset Class," *Journal of Private Equity* (2001).
