### **Nicolas Rohatyn**

Nicolas Rohatyn is Chief Executive Officer and Chief Investment Officer of TRG Management LP (the Investment Manager) where he oversees the overall strategy and management of the firm's Funds. He will also serve in this capacity for any future Funds or related managed accounts.

Throughout his 19 year career at J.P. Morgan, Mr. Rohatyn held a variety of leadership positions in emerging markets, foreign exchange, commodities, credit markets and e-commerce functions. He served as a member of J.P. Morgan's executive management team for five years. As Managing Director and Head of Emerging Markets Sales, Trading and Research, Mr. Rohatyn established offices in Mexico, South Africa, Turkey, Russia, Korea, and India, as part of the growth of J.P. Morgan's efforts in those markets. Mr. Rohatyn built and restructured the emerging markets sales, trading and research area from a loan-based business to an integrated and diversified sales, trading and capital markets effort while producing significant net income and winning numerous awards and industry-wide recognition. During his tenure, J.P. Morgan established its widely acknowledged leadership position in emerging markets securities distribution, trading, and research.

Mr. Rohatyn was a founder, and served for four years as a chairman of the Emerging Markets Traders Association (EMTA), a body that today is recognized by many professionals as the authority on market standards, practices and volumes. He currently serves on the boards of MarketAxess, The Alvin Ailey American Dance Theatre, and Robert College of Istanbul. In the past, he served on the boards of the Local Initiatives Support Corporation (LISC), the RiskMetrics Group, Archipelago, and the Lewis T. Preston Foundation for Girls. A native New Yorker, Mr. Rohatyn holds a Bachelor of Arts in Economics from Brown University.
